How to Care for Your Appliance

- Before Inserting the Device: Brush and floss your teeth, then thoroughly rinse your mouth and the device with clean water.
 - Mouthwash Use: If you use mouthwash at bedtime, thoroughly rinse your mouth with water afterward to remove all traces of mouthwash.
- After Using the Device:
 - Cleaning: Use a 3.8% or less peroxide-based appliance cleaner according to the instructions on the box.
 - Rinsing: Thoroughly wash the inside and exterior of the upper and lower splints with cool, clear water.
 - Drying: Shake off excess water and allow the appliance to air dry completely.
 - Storage: Once dry, store the device in its storage case. Keep it at room temperature and out of direct sunlight.
- Precautions:
 - Avoid Soaking: Do not soak the device in mouthwash, denture cleanser, hot water, or alcohol.
 - Avoid Certain Cleaning Agents: Do not wash the device with soap, toothpaste, or mouthwash.
 - Avoid Heat: Do not dry the device with a blow dryer or expose it to direct sunlight.

Warranty and Longevity

- Warranty: Your Silent Nite Sleep Appliance comes with a two-year warranty from the date of manufacture. This covers any defects in materials or workmanship.
- Expected Lifespan: With proper care, your appliance should last between 3 to 5 years.
- Replacement: It is recommended to replace the appliance every 3 to 5 years to ensure maximum effectiveness and hygiene. Regular check-ups with your dentist will help determine the optimal time for replacement.
